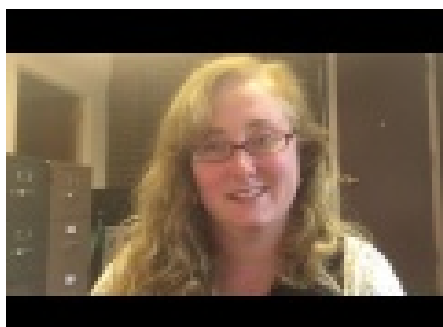

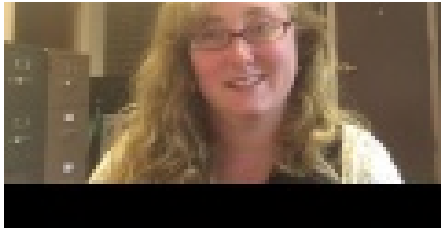

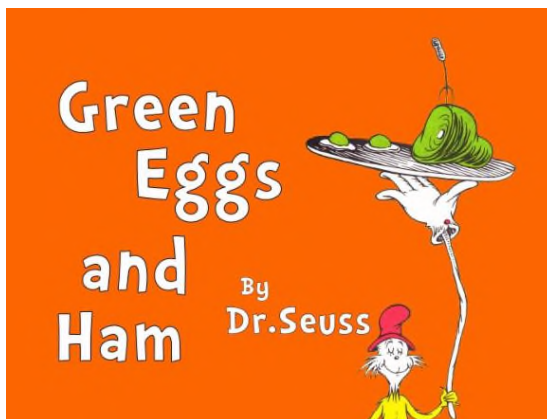

"On July 24, [as part of the 150th Anniversary video], Linda Goff arranged to have a videographer, John Smay, come over to take some footage in the gardens, and that went very well. It was an overcast morning, making it better for photos, and things looked really good in the veggie and pollinator gardens

Attached are some pictures of Linda holding a bunch of carrots - and they were the perfect size for harvesting, as were most of the beets. She's standing between the two buckets filled with kale, chard, lettuce, more carrots and beets. Everything was dropped off at Cafe on Vine, and as usual, was gratefully received and will be put to good use.

We put in some more carrot, beet, and lettuce seeds as a successive planting. Here's hoping! The second planting of carrots did very well last year - so we'll see ...

Great news! We found FIVE Monarch caterpillars on the milkweed plants in the pollinator garden! I believe that Dane and Sarah Moulton will be taking care of these little beauties. It was definitely a high point of my day to see them on the plants that went in the ground two and three years ago with such high hopes!"
