“Children in No Man’s Land” film — Marcy Doyle

March 1: The Immigration Project of the Social Justice Team will present the film "Children in No Man's Land." This award winning documentary follows the dangerous journey of two young cousins traveling alone and undocumented from Puebla, Mexico, to Chicago across the U.S./Mexican border. The film follows them on two attempts to cross the Sonora Desert to reunite with their mothers and shows footage of other children caught in detention. (39 minutes, Spanish with English subtitles.) Marcy Doyle will entertain discussion as time allows and the discussion will continue with anyone interested after the 11:15 a.m. service.

Governance Task Force: Update on Policy Based Governance

March 8: The Bylaws Governance Team has completed a preliminary set of Board policies regarding the finances of the Congregation. It includes what is delegated to the Administration of the Congregation and what powers are reserved for the Board. The policies address budgets, asset protection, accounting, fundraising, gifts and others. These are broad Board policies, not the detailed Administrative policies and procedures in the Administry Manual, which will describe the day-to-day management of the Congregation. These have been affirmed but not adopted by the Board. Adoption will occur after the Congregational input received at the Forum March 8.
