

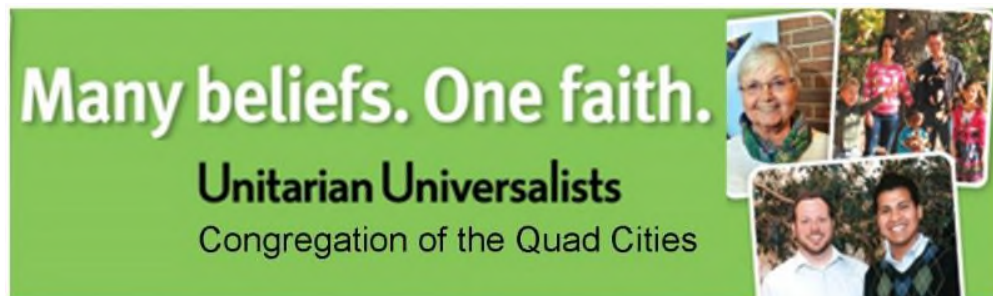

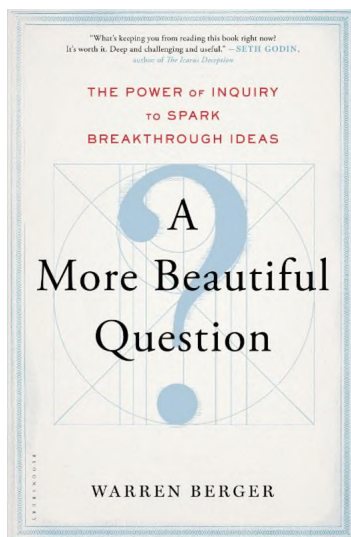

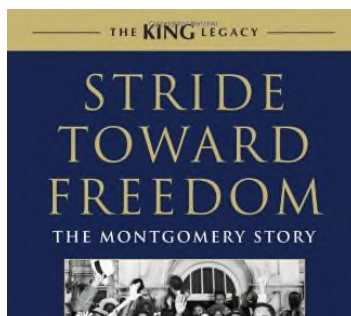

A More Beautiful Question? Inspired by the book of the same name, Connie Ghinazzi and Lucia Dryanski will investigate the power of inquiry to ignite change.

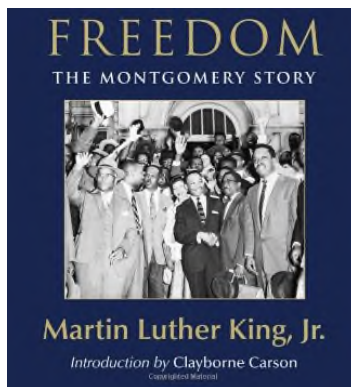

Rev. Jay Wolin is on Study Leave and will return to the office Tuesday, Jan. 12.

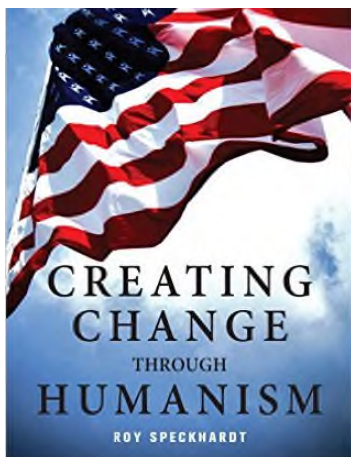


The Happy Human Book Club
